


No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind.

- 5. Consider Consequences!
- 6. Repeat the above

Follow Up: HEAD




Read **James 1:13-15**

- Where does sin start?
- What are the stages in the development of sin?
- Where does it ultimately end?

Read 2 Samuel 11

- David should have been with his men in battle but stayed at home. What is the lesson in temptation for us?
- David walked on his roof at night from where he could see Bathsheba. What is the lesson in temptation for us?
- David's sin then developed in stages, ending in death. Map these stages against what you read in James 1:13-15


Follow Up: HEAD



Read 2 Samuel 12:1-20


- How would you describe David's initial response to Nathan?
- What caused this hardening of his heart?
- What do you think caused David to repent?
- What were the consequences of David's sin?
- What are some of the consequences of our lust and impurity if left to develop into full-blown sin?
- David's repentance led him to the temple to worship God. What is the lesson in this for us?

Follow up: HEART




- How would you say the battle for purity is going in your life?
- Is purity an occasional struggle or a continual one?
- Are you being consistently open with spiritual men about your struggles?
- How often do you see or speak to these brothers?
- Is purity a topic that you are readily open about? Is there anything holding you back?

Follow Up: HANDS



- If you have not already done so, establish a relationship with a brother who will help you fight the battle for purity
- Who do you plan to contact? Talk to them this week
- Immediately start to implement the steps to defeat temptation in
 60 seconds (Pray Move Wait Get help Consider Consequences)
- Memorise 1 Corinthians 10:13 and recall this scripture when you expect temptation
- Think of one or two other scriptures you can memorise to help you overcome temptation
